How to get started:

- Contact Accessibility Services Office and arrange to meet with the coordinator.
- Be prepared to:
 - Discuss your needs and request accommodations
 - Provide documentation that verifies functional limitations and supports your accommodation requests (in most cases we can send for that information with a signed release)
 - Agree on reasonable accommodations, you will receive a letter with your accommodations outlined so that you can speak with your professor.
 - Accommodations address your barriers to access college materials, classrooms, facilities, etc. Knowing your challenges helps us to write an effective accommodation plan.
