2. Review what accommodations you may have in the past and the effectiveness in high school.
3. Connect with our office (emailing to request an appointment is the best way to connect) to make an appointment to discuss accommodation (if at all possible try to do this before the start of the semester so that accommodations are in place before classes begin).
4. Attend meetings and be ready to discuss the accommodations you are requesting and how the accommodations will help you access our campus
