HOW TO GET STARTED

1. Have your most recent school psychological evaluation or other documentation that states the impairment and how it affects you in an academic setting.
 2. Review what accommodations you have had in the past and its effectiveness in high school.
 3. Call the center to make an appointment to discuss accommodations (if at all possible try to do so before the start of the semester so that accommodations are in place before classes begin).
 4. Attend an informational meeting and be ready to discuss the accommodations you are requesting as well as how the accommodations will help you access our campus.
