HOW TO GET STARTED

1. Submit current documentation of disability to the Office of Accessibility Resources (OAR) prior to scheduling a placement test or at the start of the semester.
2. Call the OAR to make an appointment to discuss accommodations (if possible try to make the appointment before the start of the semester so that accommodations are in place before classes begin).
3. Meet with an Accessibility Specialist at the beginning of each semester to discuss the accommodations you are requesting and develop an accommodation plan.
4. Present your accommodation plan to your instructors.
