HOW TO GET STARTED

1. Before you call have your most recent school psychological evaluation or other documentation that states the impairment and how it affects you in an academic setting.
2. Review what accommodations you may have in the past and the effectiveness in high school.
3. Call the office to make an appointment to discuss accommodation (if at all possible try to do before the start of the semester so that accommodations are in place before classes begin).
4. Attend meeting and be ready to discuss the accommodations you are requesting and how the accommodations will help you access our campus.
