## How To Receive Services

1. Self-identify to the assistant director of Academic Services.
2. Provide current documentation from a qualified professional such as a physician, licensed psychologist or other practitioner who is skilled in the diagnosis of disability.
3. Contact the assistant director of Academic Services to schedule a meeting to discuss appropriate services and/or accommodations.

Since all documents/records are held confidentially in the office of the assistant director, students must schedule an appointment each semester to obtain a confidential notification form to be distributed to current faculty. These notification forms contain only information regarding accommodations.

Successful accommodations require advanced planning. Please notify the assistant director of Academic Services in an effective and timely manner.

## Opportunities and Services Available

- ⇒ Be registered as a student with a disability
- ⇒ Have at least a 3.1 QPA and 24 credit hours completed as an undergraduate
- ⇒ Have at least a 3.3 QPA and 18 credit hours completed as a graduate

### Workforce Recruitment Program (WRP)

Hilbert College is a member of WRP which is a recruitment and referral program that connects federal sector employers nationwide with highly motivated college students and recent graduates with disabilities who are eager to prove their abilities in the workplace through summer or permanent jobs.

### Transition and Academic Counseling
