## To Receive Accommodations at Medaille

1. Be an accepted or currently enrolled student at Medaille
2. Submit current and relevant documentation of diagnosed disability type(s), which may include:
  - A letter from a qualified, licensed professional that states any diagnosis relevant to requested accommodations AND current substantial limitations
  - A statement of recommended accommodations
  - A copy of assessments or evaluations used to determine the diagnoses
  - Any additional documentation that supports your request (IEP, 504 plan)
3. Schedule an intake appointments with the Coordinator of Accessibility Services
