HOW TO GET STARTED

STEP 1: **SUBMIT A REGISTRATION FORM**

All information is confidential and is securely maintained.

STEP 2: **PROVIDE ELIGIBILITY DOCUMENTATION**

If you received accommodations in high school, you may provide a copy of your most recent Individualized Education Plan (IEP), Psychological evaluation, or a 504 plan. Due to the interactive nature of the intake process, we recommend that you provide as much recent documentation as possible to help substantiate requests for accommodations.

Declassification documentation, coupled with the disability classification, can also be used as grounds for eligibility.

STEP 3: **SCHEDULE AN APPOINTMENT**

After your documentation is reviewed, we will contact you, via email, to schedule an appointment for an interactive intake meeting. At this meeting, we will talk about your strengths and needs as a learner and develop a plan of support in the form of an accommodation letter.

STEP 4: **OBTAIN YOUR OFFICIAL ACCOMMODATION LETTER**

You'll leave this meeting empowered to disclose your accommodation letter, to self-advocate for your needs, and to take advantage of the community and college-wide resources that are available to help you reach your goals.
