ACCESSIBILITY SERVICES

HOW TO GET STARTED

- Students seeking accommodations, academic adjustments, and/or auxiliary aids and services, must first make an appointment to meet with the Accessibility Services Program Administrator to register for support services. Appointments can be made by calling 716-614-6728 or emailing access@niagaracc.suny.edu.
- At this appointment, the student should identify themselves as having a disability and should provide the AS Program Administrator with complete diagnostic testing and/or medical assessment documents from a qualified medical professional.
 - Acceptable documentation can include an IEP, psychological evaluation, 504 plan, detailed letter from a physician that diagnoses disability and explains how it affects the student’s academics, etc. The AS Program Administrator may also request further documentation to support the request for accommodations.
- Once the documentation is deemed adequate and/or verified, the AS Program Administrator will provide the student with an email via student TWolves email account with the student’s approved accommodations and informational resources. All current and future instructors will also be notified of academic adjustments.
