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### HOW TO GET STARTED

1. Contact Accessibility Resources to arrange an initial meeting. Meetings may take place in person, over the phone or online, as needed. If you require accommodations for the meeting, please let us know when you make your appointment.
2. You can request a variety of reasonable accommodations at UB, including note-taking assistance, accessible textbooks, testing accommodations and assistive equipment.
3. If Accessibility Resources determines that your request for accommodation is reasonable, we will provide you with an Accommodation Memo via email every semester.
4. Once you receive your Accommodation Memo, it is your responsibility to inform faculty and staff of any accommodations that they may need to know about. The Accessibility Resources staff will provide an orientation and support in this communication process.
